What is a Sex Crime?

Strict definitions are a key part of Utah's legal system and those definitions don't always line up with what you might think. Here's a quick summary of the more common sex crimes:

- **Sexual Acts Without Consent:**

If the victim of a sexual act did not expressly consent to the act, regardless of the reason why, then the sexual act is considered a sexual offense. [Learn More](#)

- **Rape:**

Having sexual intercourse when the victim has either denied consent or is incapable of consenting, regardless of whether the person is your married spouse, counts as rape under Utah law. [Learn More](#)

- **Aggravated Sexual Assault:**

Aggravated sexual assault is a secondary charge that is added to any attempted or actual forcible penetration or sexual abuse of a victim which involved violence, dangerous weapons, threats, or more than one person as the perpetrator. [Learn More](#)

- **Forcible Sex Abuse:**

Any “indecent liberties” (touching genitals or buttocks, for example) the defendant committed or that the defendant caused to be committed. [Learn More](#)

- **Child Rape:**

In Utah, this means any sexual interaction with a person under the age of 18. [Learn More](#)

- **Enticing a Minor:**

Even if the person under the age of 18 participates willingly in a sexual act, it’s still illegal. [Learn More](#)
(Classified under subsection 2;)

- **Sexual Solicitation:**

Any offer of compensation (cash or otherwise) in return for sexual services, even if the offer isn’t made to the person performing the sexual act, is considered prostitution. [Learn More](#)

- **Sex Offender Registry Issues:**

Any failure to register, whether total or partial, is grounds for jail time, probation, and an extended stint on the sex offender registry. [Learn More](#)
