Charges of Criminal Mischief, often called vandalism, are filed due to property damage or destruction. The Criminal Mischief charge is frequently added to more serious charges for other alleged offenses. Criminal Mischief Laws in Utah

Criminal Mischief is defined under Utah law as intentionally damaging someone else's property, leading to recklessly endangering a person's life, safety, or health. It's also defined simply as defacing, damaging, destroying another person's property.

The charge of [Criminal Mischief in Utah](#) is often added to other charges. For example, in [domestic violence assault](#) cases, when the person charged has also damaged a cell phone, TV, computer, etc., prosecutors might also charge Criminal Mischief.

The court typically requires a person convicted of this violation under the state statutes to reimburse any federal, state, or local government department, private organization, business, or person for all their expenses incurred in the case.

What Can Make Criminal Mischief a Felony?

The subsections under [Title 76 of the Utah Criminal Code, Chapter 6](#), Offenses Against Property, Property Destruction, Section 106, on Criminal Mischief detail the levels of Criminal Mischief offenses.

Classifications of Criminal Mischief, range from a [Class B misdemeanor](#) to a [third degree felony](#). The degree of the crime charged is determined based on the value of property that has been destroyed or damaged. For example, in a case in which the property damaged is valued at a few thousand dollars or more, the defendant is charged with a felony.

Here are the kinds of [acts that constitute Criminal Mischief](#), under Utah law:

- *Damaging property for the purpose of defrauding the insurer*
- *Illegally and intentionally tampering with another person's property and, by doing so, recklessly causing endangerment to someone's life, safety or health*
- *Illegally and intentionally tampering with someone else's property and, as a result, recklessly causing risk of major interruption or negative impact on the functioning of essential infrastructure, like a banking, communications, information, food distribution, or transportation system, or a utility, or a healthcare or public health facility*
- *Illegally and intentionally defacing, destroying, or [damaging another person's property](#)*
- *Willfully or recklessly shooting at, or propelling an object at a car, truck, train, airplane, boat or other motorized vehicle*

Consequences if You are Found Guilty of Criminal Mischief in Utah

If you are found guilty of a crime defined under the [Utah Criminal Mischief law](#), the consequences can vary, potentially including:

- *Large fines*
- *Community service*
- *Restitution for damage*
- *Jail sentence*
- *Prison sentence*
- *Counseling*
- *Other consequences*

It is not uncommon for the [consequences of a Criminal Mischief conviction](#) to include a combination of the above penalties.

Additionally, a person convicted of the charge of Criminal Mischief in Utah is required to pay all of the state's and other involved parties' costs in the case.
