Punishments for Unlawful Sexual Activity with a Minor

Under Utah law, a conviction of unlawful sexual activity with a minor may result in a jail or prison sentence and a large fine, plus registering as a sex offender. Depending on the <u>specifics of your case</u>, you may be charged with and convicted of one of these classes of crime:

Class B Misdemeanor:

Conviction of a Class B Misdemeanor can result in a maximum fine of \$1,000 and a maximum jail term of 6 months.

Third-Degree Felony:

A <u>Third Degree felony</u> conviction can result in a maximum sentence of a \$5,000 fine and 5 years in prison.

If a defendant is under four years older than the victim when the offense occurs, the charge is reduced from a Third Degree felony to a Class B misdemeanor. A Salt Lake City criminal attorney can help you make sure that all the possible reductions of charges and/or sentences to which you are entitled are applied.

Becoming a Registered Sex Offender

If you are convicted of a sex crime involving a minor in Utah, you must register as a sex offender for a minimum of 10 years. During those years, you will be required to re-register at set intervals to avoid additional criminal charges, and you will be prohibited from visiting many public places and other locations, among other restrictions.

The <u>Utah sex offender registry</u> contains a public display of your picture, name, age, home and work addresses, and license plate numbers, along with the crime you were found guilty of and the date of the conviction. It can prevent you from working in your preferred employment and even stop you from living in your desired neighborhood, among other consequences.
